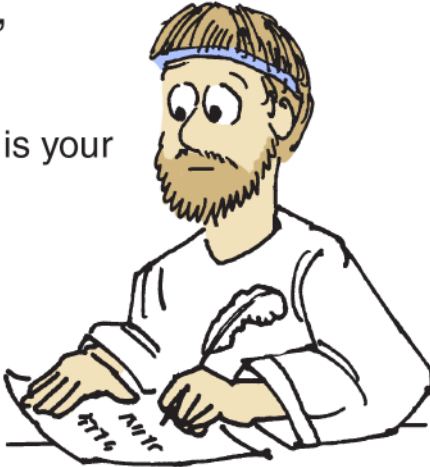
Victory Over Death

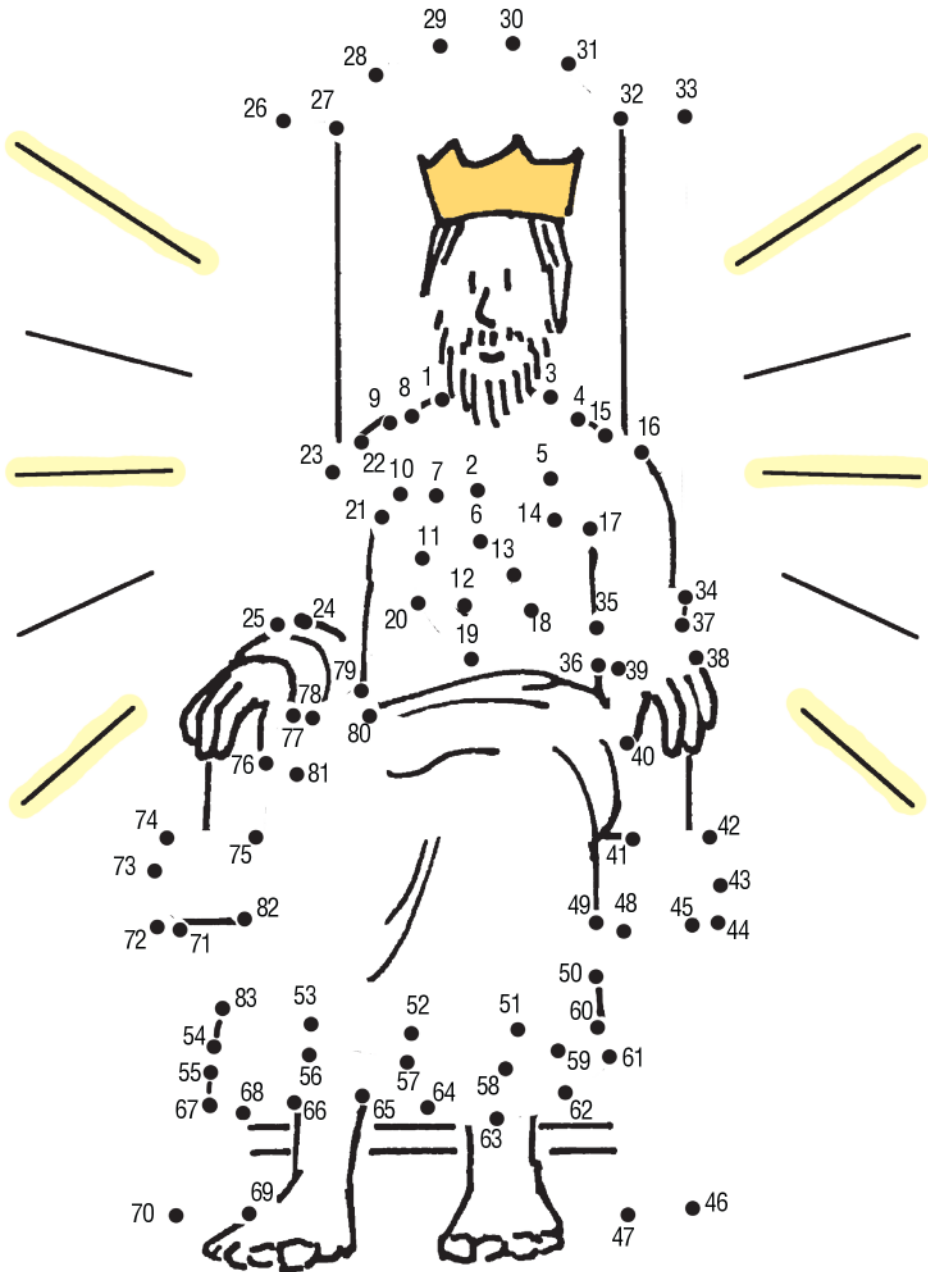
