King Saul thought David was his enemy. He took 3,000 able young men from all Israel and set out to look for David.

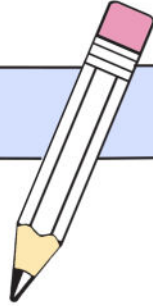
